- If you need a time proven recipe for relish etc. call Cathie in the office. A church member recently turned in copies of her favourite recipes from many years of use.

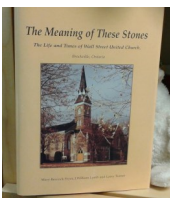
